

# Fair Credit Reporting Statement

---

The Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act, Driver's Privacy Protection Act, analogous state laws, and other state and federal laws govern the use of reports delivered via the PURE system. It is your responsibility to ensure that your requests are lawful. When ordering reports for underwriting purposes, you must have a completed application and/or the verbal request of the subject consumer.

The Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act imposes criminal penalties - including a fine, up to two years in prison, or both - against anyone who knowingly and willfully obtains information on a consumer from a consumer reporting agency under false pretenses, and other penalties for anyone who obtains such consumer information without a permissible purpose.

We require that you read the following statement to applicants and obtain their acknowledgement before proceeding with a quote.

As part of the application process, Privilege Underwriters Reciprocal Exchange (PURE) may request consumer reports that provide information on your driving record, claims history and/or credit score. If you request, PURE will inform you of any consumer reports acquired, and provide you with the name and address of the consumer reporting agency that furnished the report.
